## **PWRDF and the Famine Relief Fund**

The Primate's World Relief and Development Fund is pleased to report that the federal government has announced they will match funds donated to Canadian NGOs for famine relief in Africa and the Middle East.

The Famine Relief Fund will run until June 30. This means for every \$1 donated to PWRDF's famine appeal the government will put \$1 into its Famine Relief Fund (for the government to allocate). The 1:1 match will be applied retroactively to all funds donated since March 17. More than \$140,000 has been donated since our appeal was announced, and money is still coming in from individuals and churches across Canada.
