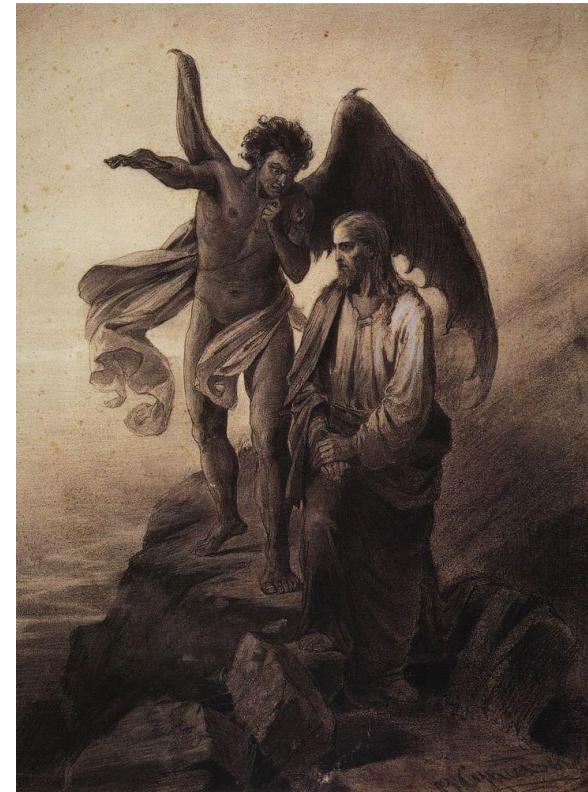

## Bookkeeper Needed – YouthNet

YouthNet requires a new bookkeeper. Tasks include bi-weekly payroll, printing cheques, entering expenses and revenue into Simply Accounting, monthly VISA and bank reconciliations and creating monthly financial statements. This position also requires year end preparation and assisting auditors, as well as working with ED and Treasurer to develop the annual budget. This position requires 3 to 4 hours of work once every two weeks and this person would ideally work in the YouthNet office during office hours. The position is best suited for someone who has experience with non-profit bookkeeping and Simply Accounting software. ## The Lenten Fast

The Book of Common Prayer (page xiii) directs us to observe the following days of fasting, abstinence, and solemn prayer during Lent:

**Major fast days:** Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On both these days, from sunrise to sundown, we should try to go without food and water during the day.

**Days of Abstinence:** The Forty Days of Lent (this excludes the Sundays in Lent). On these days we should eat simple, smaller meals, and undertake other forms of self-denial, giving up a luxury or indulgence.

**Days of Solemn Prayer:** The Lenten Ember Days being the Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday after the First Sunday in Lent. On these days we should spend extra time in daily prayer and try our best to attend the Holy Communion.

Some people are not able to undertake these disciplines for reasons of health and wellness.

## Lenten Sunday Evensongs – Starting Today

Beginning today, and throughout Lent, a sung Evensong with organ accompaniment will be held on Sunday evenings at 5 p.m. in the Chancel of the Round Church, with a meditation offered on the Scripture readings appointed for that day. A Choral Evensong with full choir will be held on the Third Sunday of Lent (March 24th), on the Eve of the Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Consider making these Evensongs a part of your Lenten discipline of increased attention to the divine Word.

## A Holy Lent: Lenten Study Sessions

The Exhortation appointed to be read on Ash Wednesday (page 611-612) in the Book of Common Prayer directs us to "the observance of a holy Lent, by self-examination and repentance, by prayer, fasting, and self-denial, and by reading and meditation upon God's holy Word." The Rector will lead three bi-weekly sessions to help us better understand these disciplines, what the Book of Common Prayer says about them, and how we might undertake them with a renewed vigour. These sessions are especially designed for those new to the Book of Common Prayer.
